The following year we repeated this success in conjunction with the Steyning Festival in the summer, followed by a later Christmas trail. In this non-Festival year, we are running an easily accessible, walkable art trail, which focuses on the heart of our community, Steyning High Street.

Steyning Arts' aim is to showcase local arts across as broad a range of disciplines as possible including painting, sculpture, ceramics, jewellery, craft work and photography.
